He went on to study Economics at the University of Aberdeen and qualified as a chartered accountant in 1981 at Ernst & Young in Glasgow. Hugh joined Aberdeen Asset Management plc, a global investment group, as their ninth employee in 1987 successfully filling a series of roles and becoming Head of Acquisitions in 2007 before taking early retirement in 2015. Hugh is a Visiting Professor and Governor at the Robert Gordon University, and is also a non-executive director of several companies.
